Christ not only told us to pray for OUR enemies, but on our behalf, He prayed for HIS enemies – "Father, forgive them; they know not what they do." (Luke 23v34). Also, He died for His sheep while we were ungodly enemies against Him. (Rom 5v6-8)

May we be given the grace to pray for the ones that hate us, despise us and would kill us if possible. That they too may know their sin and know the One who was made sin for His people, The Lord Jesus Christ!
