The one who cannot do these things has never really seen himself.

HEAR MY VOICE

"My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish..." John 10v27-30

The Gospel is not a theological position; the Gospel is not a denominational distinctive; nor is the Gospel a verse in the Bible backed by other verses. Well, if it is not those things, what is it? Beloved, our Gospel is a person, our God and Saviour Christ Jesus the Lord.

Our Lord said "My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish..." (John 10:27-30). Beloved, what good news! 
