## SERVING BRETHREN

Regarding how we are to love our brethren the Apostle says "Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honour preferring one another; Not slothful in business; fervent in spirit; serving the Lord" (Romans 12:10-11). This service of love is further illuminated in vs 13 "Distributing (communicating) to the necessity of saints; given to hospitality". In this passage we find that helping and showing hospitality to our brethren is accomplished during times of difficulty. The most meaningful time to show love is during times of tribulation and hardship. Paul is speaking of love and fervent service in the midst of trying times. "Rejoicing in hope; patient in tribulation; continuing instant in prayer" (Romans 12:12). Imagine making sacrifices for one another during times of persecution. Be ready, he says, to serve your brethren even in the midst of tribulation. Walk in the Spirit and you shall not fulfill the lusts of the flesh which seeks to preserve self above all others. Walk in the new man, in fellowship with your God through continual prayer that you may recognize the needs of others. When the heart is set upon this world, many opportunities to serve go unnoticed. How many are lonely? How many struggle? "Watch ye, stand fast in the faith, quit you like men, be strong. Let all your things be done with charity. I beseech you, brethren, (ye know the house of Stephanas, that it is the firstfruits of Achaia, and that they have addicted themselves to the ministry of the saints" (1 Cor 16:13-15).

## Who Did God Appoint To Salvation?

Here are five truths concerning the salvation that is IN and OF our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.
