- 3. To be saved is to be **Free from the curse** of the law (Galatians 3:13).
- 4. To be saved is to be <u>Free from all possibility of condemnation</u> (Romans 8:1).
- 5. To be saved is to have **Eternal life** (1 John 5:11).
- 6. To be saved is to have the **Spirit of Christ** (Romans 8:9).
- 7. To be saved is to <u>Own and acknowledge Christ as</u> <u>Lord</u> (Romans 10:9-10).
- 8. To be saved is to be <u>In love with Jesus Christ</u> (1 Corinthians 16:22).

NOTHING DOUBTING

When the Lord sent Peter to Cornelius with the Gospel, the Holy Spirit told him, "Nothing Doubting". Acts 11:12. Oh that we could always live with nothing doubting.
