## A Tribute to Missionary Walter Groover

Last Thursday morning around 10:15, CST, our merciful Lord and God was pleased to receive Bro. Walter Groover into His eternal presence. I met Bro. Walter about 35 years ago while I was living in Franklin, TN. and have been blessed to be with him, his wife Betty, and their children many times in Mexico.

Walter, in the 1960's, worked as a crane operator in Houston, TX. and during that time providentially crossed paths with a missionary who periodically flew to Mexico to minister to the Indians there. Traveling numerous times to Mexico, Bro. Walter began to realize a burden for the country and especially for the city of Merida. In October of 1964 Walter resigned from his job in Houston and he, Betty and five children loaded a trailer and drove 5 days to Merida where they have lived since.

When I met Walter in Franklin, being truly touched with the move he and his family had made, I asked him, "*Bro. Walter, when did you know that it was the right thing to resign your job in Houston, to sell out lock, stock and barrel, pack up your family and move to a country where you didn't hardly speak the language?*" His answer was immediate, simple, pointed and truly revealing... "***When something becomes more important to you than what you're doing...you'll go.***" Obviously, the Lord had a people in Mexico and had given Bro. Walter a burden to go. Over the years our God has been pleased to bless the work there, calling out many of His sheep. Bro. Walter and Betty have truly been dear friends, and we thank our God for causing our paths to cross.
