It has often been said that a particular message was convicting. There is an old saying, 'If the shoe fits, wear it.' I say, if the message fits wear it, don't ignore it. God speaks to His people by His Spirit through His word. When the word comes in convicting power, give great attention to it.

"...thy faithfulness in the night" Psalm 92: 2

This phrase speaks of praising God's faithfulness in time of darkness. The margin reads "in the nights." Christ is the believer's Light, not in one night of darkness, but in every dark trial. "He who keeps Israel shall neither slumber nor sleep" (Ps 121: 4). As we travel through this wilderness we have the same assurance the children of Israel had, "He led them all the night with a light of fire" (Ps 78: 14).

When nights come it is not that the Sun of righteousness is not shining upon those in whom Christ is the Light of life; it is that we know not what God is doing in providence; it is to wean us from self; it is to make us value Christ our Light, to trust and stay upon HIM. This is the Lord's word to us, "Who is among you that feareth the LORD, that obeyeth the voice of his servant, that walketh in darkness, and hath no light? let him trust in the name of the LORD, and stay upon his God" (Is 50: 10). He promises, "I will bring the blind by a way that they knew not; I will lead them in paths that they have not known: I will make darkness light before them, and crooked things straight. These things will I do unto them, and not forsake them" (Is 42: 16)

In due time (His time), each believer shall sing praise declaring, "By his light I walked through darkness" (Job 29:3). It is to make us experience his faithfulness that we might praise Christ and be grown a little more so that when the next night comes we have a little more trust in Christ, being assured, "Thou wilt light my candle: the LORD my God will enlighten my darkness" (Ps 18: 28).
