AN OPENED DOOR

"For a great door and effectual is opened unto me,.."

1 Cor 16: 9

There are doors that we would like to open. But we need Christ to open the door. Paul speaks of this often. The Lord "opened the door of faith unto the Gentiles" (Act 14:27); at Troas "a door was opened unto me of the Lord" (2 Cor 2:12). Paul asked the saints to pray for him that Christ would open the door that he might preach "pray also for us, that God would open unto us a door of utterance, to speak the mystery of Christ " (Col 4: 3). Christ commands his child to open the door of the heart "Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me" (Rev 3:20) But it is Christ alone that gets the glory for opening it, "My beloved put in his hand by the hole of the door, and my bowels were moved for him" (Song 5:4) When the Lord Jesus opens we find that Christ himself is the Door as well as the one who opened, "Then said Jesus unto them again, Verily, verily, I say unto you, I am the door of the sheep...by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture" (Joh 10:7-9). We would like to open many doors that are closed to us. But Christ's power alone determines if the door is open or shut, "These things saith he that is holy, he that is true, he that hath the key of David, he that openeth, and no man shutteth; and shutteth, and no man openeth" (Rev 3:7).
