Believers Baptism

Over the years I have seen many people struggle with Baptism. "Was I a believer when I was baptized? Should I be baptized again?" There are two questions that must be answered to know if I should be satisfied with my baptism.

- (1) What is the Gospel?
- (2) Did I believe the Gospel when I was baptized?

If the Gospel I heard was not the Gospel of the Scriptures I was never baptized in the first place. A religious ritual? Yes. Christian baptism? No. Did I believe the Gospel I heard? "Whoso believeth and is baptized shall be saved." Faith in Christ is the one requirement for baptism. If you heard and believed the Gospel when you were baptized, you should be satisfied with your baptism. If you had not heard the Gospel of the Scriptures, and had not believed the Gospel you now believe when you were baptized, you were not really baptized. You cannot truly be baptized without faith in Christ. If you are satisfied that you had heard and believed the Gospel when you were baptized... thank God! If you believe you had not heard nor believed the Gospel when you were first baptized, you really never have been baptized, and it is time for you to confess Christ in believer's baptism.
