# Look Up

For those who hunger and thirst after righteousness, those who look for the preaching of Christ, this country has become a barren wilderness. In the UK we live in an increasingly secular society, one which is very barren spiritually. There are relatively few faithful meetings up and down the country, and very few faithful preachers of the gospel.

Of course, there is much religion about. Most towns will have various religious 'buildings' and meetings. You'll find Church of England places, Methodist, United Reformed, Arminian Baptist, charismatic 'community' churches etc etc. Are there places to go to? Of course.... if dead, works, free-will, religion is what you seek. But the believer won't find the Living among the dead.....

On <u>freegraceradio.com</u> there are a handful of preachers of free and sovereign grace over here. There are also a number of Gospel Standard chapels of varying size dotted about, but overall there are few places where the gospel is truly heard.

We preach the gospel down here in Exeter, brother Peter Meney is up in the Lake District, Allan Jellett is over in Hampshire. We all have tiny congregations. The gospel is preached, Christ is proclaimed, but few in the area have any interest.... But we are NOT dismayed. It is the Lord's work, and His will will be done.

I know that all believers will both seek the Truth and seek fellowship with their brethren. If that means moving to sit under the word of God, and they are able to, they will. If it means trying to make known the Truth in their own area then they will do what they can. But the reality here in the UK is that if you go to try the 'meetings' in your area you are often bitterly disappointed (as most preach a lie) and if you seek brethren in your area you often find they are few and far between. As such, the provision of faithful preaching online is a life-line for many. I do not decry it, the Lord has sent it. HE knows how to feed His sheep in this wilderness

I am often reminded of the early church. In the apostles' days persecution scattered believers. But that was God's way of sending His word to the four corners of the earth. Today, we may find ourselves scattered. We may long to be with other brethren, but if God chooses to keep us where we are, it is for a reason. He has put us where He has pleased, to be a witness to Him in that place. We may be alone (humanly speaking)... but

we are NEVER alone. Where two or three are gathered in His Name, there HE IS in the midst of them.
