#### The Cow and the Bee

"A land flowing with milk and honey" Exodus 3:17

What a wonder milk and honey is. A black cow eating green grass and producing white milk. A bee flying miles through the air and collecting nectar on its tiny feet and then processing it into sweet honey.

How opposite these two creatures are. One is huge and somewhat clumsy, and the other is tiny, but can fly with precision while finding a product to take to its hive.
