God's Hammer

- 2- The Roman soldiers, they were there out of duty. Just soldiers doing their job.
- 3- There were also at his cross some that knew and loved the Lord Jesus - His mother, John the disciple whom Jesus loved, Mary Magdalene and two other women (v. 25).

They weren't at a distance but "stood by the cross". There were five of them - four women and one man. Saints loved by their Lord and saints that loved their Master.
