Christ Is All, And In All

Have You Ever Been Lost?

To some that is a moot point because they believe he died for all men without exception. But according to the Bible, He only died for His sheep (John 10:16). Not everybody is a sheep. There are also goats. So how can I know that I am one for whom He died. Am I simply to have faith that He died for me? No. You can believe that He died for you and that does not mean He did. Faith is not believing He died for you. Faith is not believing you are saved. Those things have to do with assurance. When the Ethiopian eunuch asked Phillip, "What hinders me from being baptized?" Phillip said, "If you believe with all your heart you may." Notice what the eunuch did not reply. He did not say, "I believe that Christ died for me personally" or "I believe that I am saved." He said, "I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God." It is believing that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the Living God: it is believing that He is the only successful Savior and that He is able to save you. Do you believe the Gospel? If you answer no, that is no assurance that Christ died for you. But if you believe the Gospel, yes, Christ most assuredly died for you. "And as many as were ordained to eternal life believed" (Acts 13:48).
